



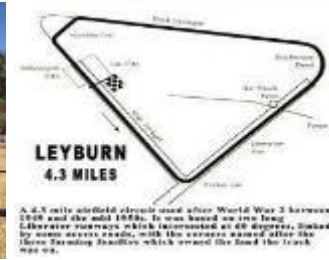
CLUB TORQUE
