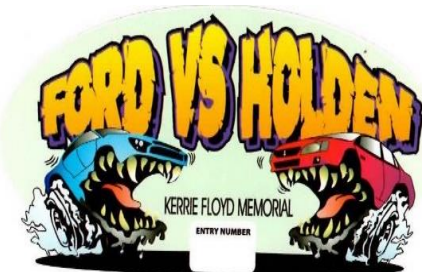




## CLUB TORQUE
