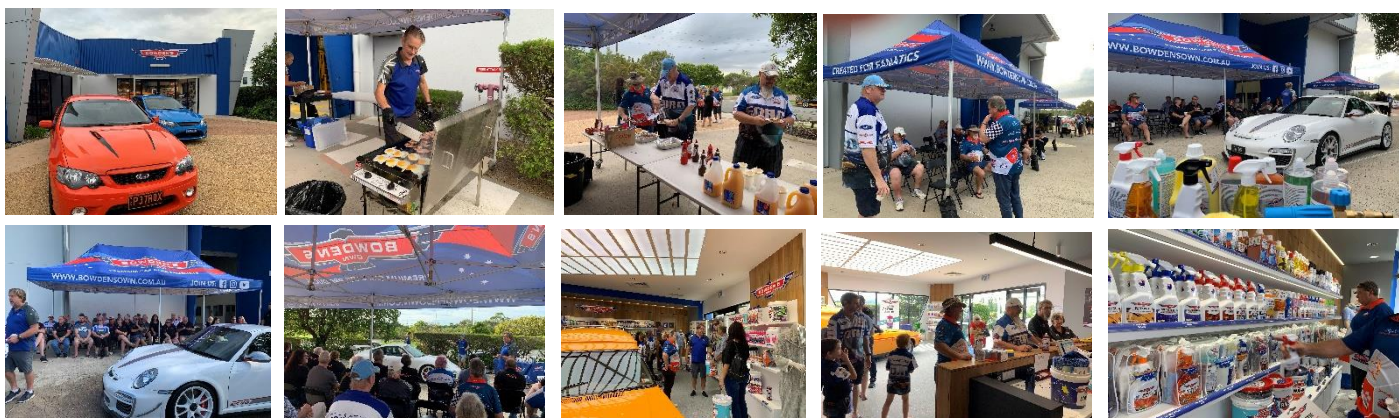




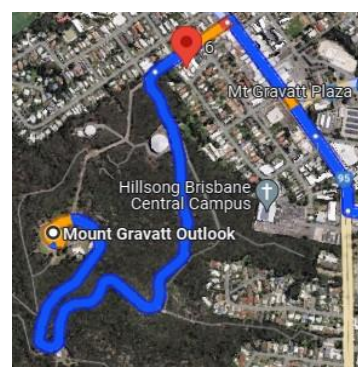
CLUB TORQUE
